Hose on half speed:

3-5 minutes per tree

Larger trees:

A full 5 minutes

Perennials:

30 seconds - 1 minute

Check your soil prior to any watering.

In these temperatures, you might water once every week or so. If your soil is retaining moisture, skip and re-check in a few days.

Pro-tip: **Evergreens** are one of those most important families to keep watered going into our dry winter wind months.
